



PASTOR'S PAGE

On November 1, I celebrated my one year anniversary with the people of God at Prince of Peace. WOW! That went fast!! In the time I've had to reflect on the past year, I've come up with a few things that feel important to say right now:

- Thank you for welcoming me into your lives. Each month throughout the year I've looked at the church directory photos that hang across from my office door, and I still don't know everyone's names, but I'm a lot closer! Thank you for continuing to be patient with me.
- We have big dreams. The Major Gifts Committee and Church Council have deliberated, and the Dahlen Family has approved the decision to distribute their bequest in (near) equal thirds. 1. There will be a brand new Philip & Eunice Dahlen Playground for Peli. 2. There will be a Dahlen Scholarship set up for expenses related to faith formation and education. 3. And we will conduct a feasibility study with architects and contractors to imagine a fellowship hall that has an outside entrance/drive up and fire safe exits that will allow it to be licensed for use by Peli and more accomodating for community ministry with people of all abilities.
- There are more dreams...The Church Council has said that 10% (30K) of the approximately \$300,000 we have in ERC funds will be given away to benefit others in our community and world. We will save 50K. We will designate 100K for the major expense of new heating/air conditioning system and air handler maintenance. That leaves 120K for capital improvements for our sanctuary and office space. We do not have more details just yet - but those are the broad strokes for now.
- What Prince of Peace has is GOOD and worth sharing with others. People genuinely want to grow closer to God and share Jesus' love to our neighbors and world. In this community, people of all political persuasions, economic backgrounds, ages, and life circumstances experience warmth and love with one another. I see Prince of Peace becoming known far and wide as the most loving, welcoming, fun, & compassionate Jesus community in the area.
- When beginning a new relationship, it's always a risk What happens when the honeymoon ends? From my vantage point, we are doing well - lines of communication feel open, the Holy Spirit is moving, and I look forward to waking up each day and sharing ministry with you.

God bless you as we move into Advent, start a new year together, and continue to pray for the Holy Spirit to guide our lives. -- Pastor Libby
